4 Tell-tale Signs That Your Water Heater Needs Attention

You roll out of bed on Monday ready to begin your day. You hop in the shower expecting nice hot water to get out the kinks and wash away the tiredness. But not today - the water is icy cold! You wait a bit longer, not wanting to admit the truth. But you finally do: your water heater has failed. Time to call the plumber and see how far out of whack your day will be.

Water heaters are one of the most important appliances in your home. But they are often neglected until they fail or start having other problems. An icy shower is one of the best-case scenarios for discovering you have a failed water heater. We

have seen homes destroyed by catastrophic water heater ruptures. And although we focus a lot on furnace safety, gas water heaters are just as big a risk for carbon monoxide in your home.

The good news is that there are symptoms that can alert you that a water heater is having problems before something happens. Here are 4 signs you can look for:

1) "Popping" or Percolating noises from your gas water heater

These noises are typically caused by sediment buildup at the bottom of the tank. This sediment is from

minerals like calcium from hard water that accumulate over time. When the water heats up, steam bubbles beneath the sediment layers causing popping sounds as they burst.

There are two problems caused by this sediment. First, accumulated sediment can increase energy costs by reducing water heater efficiency. Second, sediment can cause the tank to overheat which can shorten tank life and cause it to crack and leak.

Flushing the tank on a regular basis can remove the accumulated sediment to reduce the noise and increase efficiency. It should be done on a regular basis. Another way to prevent sediment build up is to install a water softener. See the nearby insert to see how you can get a free water test to check your water's hardness and more.

2) Having to turn up the thermostat to get the same water temperature

This can affect both electric and gas water heaters. While it might be caused by sediment inside the water heater as described above, it can also be caused by scale and soot building up on the burner itself. Either way, it's a sign that the water heater is working ineffectively to heat your water and is costing more to operate.

3) Breaker tripping (electric)

A weak or failing breaker might explain why a breaker is continually tripping. But it could also be caused by an electric water heater that is drawing too much power. As the heating elements in an electric water heater begin to deteriorate, they draw more power to operate. If the power that they draw exceeds the rating of the breaker, it will cause the breaker to trip.

4) Melting plastic rings at the top of a gas water heater

If you look at the top of your water heater, you'll see plastic rings around the water inlet and outlet pipes. If these rings look discolored or melted, it means that at some point in the past, flue gases have gone into the room instead of the exhaust vent.

This indicates a potentially dangerous problem with the exhaust that is attached to the water heater. It is serious and should be evaluated.

If your water heater has any of these tell-tale signs, you should consider having the water heater serviced. Although these symptoms can be indicative of future problems, water heaters may still fail without warning. With regulations continually changing for water heaters in order to increase their efficiency, we are seeing water heaters last around 8-12 years on average. If your water heater has never been serviced, have it maintained to help it to last longer, to make certain that it's safe and to avoid costly problems. While I don't have an exact formula to 'find outstanding personnel' I can share our process and the guiding principles of what we look for when we bring a new technician onto the team.

For me, the most important criteria aren't their previous experience or technical ability. If someone is smart and has a mechanical aptitude, we can train them to do the job. But what we can't teach are the 'intangibles' – the characteristics that determine who they are as a person and how they will represent us.

Here are some of the traits and values we look for:

- A good attitude and a good work ethic.
- People with integrity that are trust-worthy.
- They have to be personable, well-mannered and polite.
- We want nice people that are pleasant with friendly demeanor.
- We want people that care about doing a good job - we don't want anybody who is complacent or indifferent.
- They have to be 'wired' with concern for your safety and well-being.
- They have to be a team-player and considerate of others.

In the interview process we try to get a sense of whether a person will fit the mold of a VHP tech. When I'm sitting across from someone in an interview, I consider whether this is someone that I would want in my house – if not, why would I send them to your house?

By gathering a team of people with similar traits and values, we have established a strong culture that embodies these characteristics and serves to reinforce them. We tap into this in the next phase of our interview process.



Here are our techs—what a great lineup!

If after the initial management interviews we think that the prospect might fit our culture, then we'll set up an opportunity for one or more of our techs to evaluate them. We do this by setting up a 'discovery day' where we allow the prospect to spend an entire day with one of our techs on the job.

Both sides get a chance to see whether it's a good match. The job prospect gets to see how we do things and get the 'inside scoop' about the company from the tech they are with to make certain this is the right opportunity for them. At the same time, our tech will get a chance to evaluate the prospect to see if they would be a good fit for our culture and to get a sense of their technical ability.

Based on our tech feedback, if it looks like a fit - and the prospect is interested in proceeding - the next steps are more objective. We perform a criminal background check, check their credit and finally send them for a pre-employment drug & alcohol screen. We don't want anyone who might make a mistake that could impact your safety because they're impaired by anything..

It's wise to hire slow, and as I have detailed, we've adopted this philosophy. We want to make sure that you're well served when we send someone to your home. Next month I'll share more.



On the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services website, faulty furnaces and water heaters are lumped together as the leading cause of carbon monoxide poisoning in Michigan.
