THROUGH MY EYES

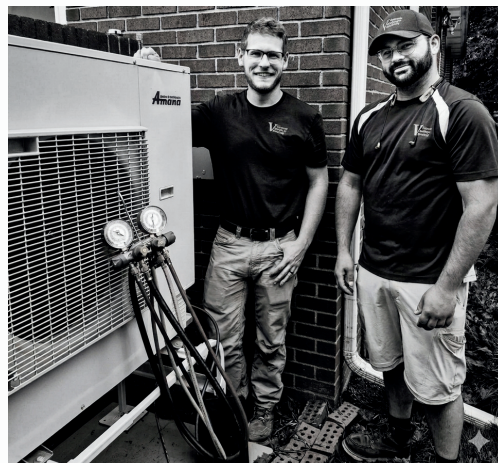

What Happens When Fresh Air Isn't Fresh?

Common sense says that outdoor air is healthier than indoor air. We go outside to "get some fresh air." But what happens when the air outside isn't healthy to breathe? This summer, over 800 fires in the Canadian wilderness created a thousand-mile smoke cloud that drifted into many states, including Michigan. Microscopic, airborne particles from this smoke made outdoor air unsafe to breathe.

This event may have seemed unprecedented, but it is not. The frequency and intensity of Canadian wildfires have increased

in recent years. Air quality warnings were issued in 2023 and 2025 due to these fires. If the trend continues, we will see more summers like this.

Houses are not airtight. All outdoor pollutants will make their way indoors. If hazardous outdoor air is becoming more common, how do we ensure our air is safe to breathe? **Fortunately, there are several proven ways to improve your home's indoor air quality and reduce your family's exposure to these contaminants.**

Upgrade to a High Efficiency Filter

Getting a more efficient filter might seem like the obvious solution. However, if your system has a 1" filter, a high efficiency filter may raise your energy bills or cause damage to equipment over the long term. High efficiency filters are denser than normal filters and make equipment work harder. To prevent this, have a larger, 4" filter installed. If this is not possible, then install a 1" polarized media air cleaner (PMAC). These devices use an electrical charge to trap particles and avoid some equipment strain caused by high-density materials.

Add HEPA Filtration

For homeowners seeking the highest level of particle removal, HEPA filtration is recommended. HEPA filters are used in hospitals and other environments where

exceptionally clean air is necessary. They capture extremely small airborne particles that standard filtration systems miss.

Because HEPA filtration is so restrictive, it can't be installed directly in a home's ductwork. Instead, specialized bypass systems continuously clean a portion of the home's air and return it to the system. When combined with a quality filter, HEPA filtration provides exceptional protection against smoke and other microscopic pollutants.

Use UV Light To Help Eliminate Odors

Even after smoke particles are removed, unpleasant odors can linger. That's where ultraviolet (UV) technology can help. While filters are designed to capture particles, UV systems can help break down certain airborne compounds responsible for persistent odors. In homes affected by

wildfire smoke, UV technology may help reduce the smoky smell that can remain even after the haze is gone.

Many UV systems can also help address other airborne contaminants, making them a valuable addition to a comprehensive indoor air quality strategy.

Don't wait for another air quality warning to make sure your home is protected from outdoor pollutants. The right combination of filtration and air treatment can help remove smoke particles, reduce lingering odors, and provide cleaner air for your family. Salvation Army Band perform during their free July concert series, put a reminder in your calendar for next year. There's just something special about the way a brass band fills the air with a richness of sound and music that we've largely lost in this age of streaming and small speakers.

Band music holds a special place for me because I played trombone at Port Huron High School and later with the St. Clair County Community College concert band. As a bonus, that's also where I met Karen all those years ago. I know what goes into making that kind of music happen. I started playing in sixth grade, and a lot of hard work goes into learning an instrument well. It takes years of practice, discipline, and sacrifice. I remember many times when I would have rather been out with friends than inside practicing my trombone. Like most worthwhile things in life, excellence doesn't happen by accident.

Now magnify that by the effort required to blend dozens of musicians together with precision. And more is required than just talented players.
